

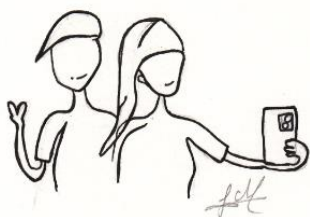
Practical Local Sustainable Development Course for Youth Workers

On December 2022 the project partners finalized the first draft of the course addressed to Youth Workers.

The course consists of 7 modules, each one developed by a project partner:

1. Sustainable development – developed by A & A Emphasys Interactive Solutions Ltd, Cyprus
2. SDGs and their importance - Parents' Association "Step by Step", Croatia
3. The 3 pillars of sustainability –developed by RUSENSKA TARGOVSKO INDUSTRIALNA KAMARA, Bulgaria
4. What prevents sustainable development from happening? – Projects in Motions Limited, Malta
5. How young people are contributing to SDGs? - Politeknika Txorierrri, Spain
6. Advocating green themes and policies - Asociatia pentru Dezvoltare si Mediu –ADEMED, Romania
7. Local actions for community development – LINK Group, Serbia

Each module has minimum 3 learning units. The course was designed taking into account the preferred learning methods of Generation Z:



independently, even in a team (Semiller & Grace, 2016).

The course matches the main learning requirements of Generation Z, that 's why is designed by delivering useful tools for Sustainable Development ready to apply after completion. Its design includes diagrams and graphics, to facilitate rapid understanding.
