Emphasys has recently come back from the 2nd Transnational Partners Meeting of the GENZ4GREENDEAL project, and we want to share our news with you!

The meeting took place on the 13th of December, in Belgrade, Serbia, at the LINK GROUP's premises.

The GENZ4GreenDeal Project aims to develop a training and capacity-building program for young people to actively participate in the development of their (local) community and environment. In order to achieve this, the partnership has already mapped the best practices in each partner country that are related to green topics and sustainable development. Furthermore, the consortium has developed a detailed Methodological framework and a Handbook for youth workers consisting of educational materials for the GenZ4GD course. The course's 7 different modules are the following:

1. Sustainable development - Emphasys Centre
2. SDGs and their importance - PASBS
3. The 3 pillars of sustainability - RCCI
4. What prevents sustainable development from happening? - PiM
5. How are young people contributing to SDGs? - Politeknika Txorierrri
6. Advocating green themes and policies - ADEMED
7. Local actions for community development – LINK GROUP

The 7 partner organisations during the meeting met and discussed the progress on the abovementioned matters. The partners, therefore, presented the material they developed as part of PR2 (PR2: GENZ4GD online course) and gave feedback to each other aiming to make it more interesting for the GENZ!

Emphasys has presented its own module, Sustainable development, which is fundamental to understanding sustainable development, the history behind it, and the reasons that led to the need for it. The module explains also what
