Politeknika Txorierri recently participated in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Transnational Partners' Meeting of the GENZ4GD project that took place in Belgrade, Serbia.

The project stemmed from the belief that young people need to be both encouraged and empowered to participate in translating the 2030 Sustainable Development Goal agenda into local, regional, and national policy.

On December 13<sup>th</sup>, during the one-day meeting, partners discussed the second and most comprehensive result of the project: a detailed methodological framework and a Handbook for youth workers consisting of a 7-module course. It covers the following topics:

1. Sustainable development
2. SDGs and their importance
3. The 3 pillars of sustainability
4. What prevents sustainable development from happening?
5. How are young people contributing to SDGs?
6. Advocating green themes and policies
7. Local actions for community development

Each partner had the chance to present a first draft of their own module and give feedback to peers to shape the course towards a final version, which will set the roadmap for the GenZ4GD Podcasts (the third project result).
